The meeting was called to order at 7:05.

1. Minutes from the September 27th meeting adopted.
2. Membership – 111; unchanged from previous report

Janet commented that new and renewing CCCTS members for 2022 will be required to attest that they have been fully vaccinated.

3. Finance – Vancity bank balance = \$689; unchanged from previous report
4. Rides

There was some discussion on the subject of leader recruitment and orientation with reference to the steps that 050 has taken (as documented in two 050 documents shared with the Committee), recognizing that the FV and 050 ride programs are quite different.

David, Ralph and Janet would give some thought to what needs to be done (or not) in preparation for the new riding season beginning in February, 2022.

5. Hub and Spoke in 2022

It was agreed to organize a Hub and Spoke in 2022 and mention/promote the event at the AGM.

Janet and Mieke volunteered to do some preliminary planning and will recruit others to help them.

6. Advocacy (Neil McNeill)

The Coalition (HUB, CCCTS, 0-5-0 and Team Coastal) has been asked to provide input on the two proposed Nikomekl River bridge projects (King George Blvd., 152nd) and Neil will be the key contact.

Work on the improvements to 32nd Ave. from Hwy. 99 to 160th continue but two “gaps” remain for cyclists remain.

Neil encouraged SC members to complete the on line survey for the City of White Rock’s draft Integrated Transportation and Infrastructure Master Plan (ITIMP) at https://www.talkwhiterock.ca/transportation/survey_tools/draft-transportation-master-plan-survey

However, the survey closed October 29th.
