### **Interested in Becoming a CCCTS Board Member?**

The overall direction and activities of CCCTS are overseen by the Board of Directors. According to the CCCTS Bylaws:

25(3) – There shall be ten (10) Directors or other such number, as determined from time to time at a general meeting, and

26(1) – The Directors shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting. Directors will serve for a two-year term with approximately one half of the Directors being elected each year.

Normally, there are 10 Board meetings per year with no meeting in July and August. Meetings take place via Zoom. The President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer are officers of CCCTS. Other directors have leadership responsibility for specific activities (e.g., International tours, North American tours, Hub and Spokes). The Minutes from CCCTS Board meetings which are posted on the website provide a good overview of the Board's activities.
